Last year, MATRIA by Álvaro Gago was premiered at Panorama Berlinale 2023, and CREATURA by Elena Martín Gimeno won the Europa Cinemas Label as Best European film in the 2023 Directors' Fortnight section at Cannes festival. Other recent titles include Clara Roquet's LIBERTAD (Semaine de la Critique at Cannes 2021) or Núria Gimenez Lorang's MY MEXICAN BRETZEL (Best Found Footage Award at Rotterdam 2020) to name just a few.

DIRECTOR

Álvaro Gago (Vigo, 1986) was selected by Variety in 2019 as a Spanish talent to track and as a Star of Tomorrow by Screen International in 2021. In 2017 he directed the short film MATRIA, which was a 2019 Gova nominee and received the 2018 Sundance Grand Jury Prize. His follow up short film, 16 DE DECEMBRO premiered at the 2019 Locarno Film Festival and was also a Goya nominee in 2021.

CARLA SIMÓN. 2022 Fiction, Drama

As far as they can remember, the Solé family have spent every summer picking the peaches from their orchard in Alcarràs. a small village in Spain. But this year's crop could be their last, as they face eviction. The new plans for the land include cutting down the peach trees and installing solar panels, which causes a rift within the large tight-knit family. For the first time, they face an uncertain future and risk losing more than their home.

Carla Simón (1986) is a film writer and director raised in a small Catalan village. SUMMER 1993 (2017) is her autobiographical debut. It won the Best First Feature Award and the Generation Kplus Grand Prix at the Berlinale, along with three Goya awards, including Best New Director. The film was selected to represent Spain at the 2018 Oscar Academy Awards and it got the Discovery nomination at the European Film Awards. Her last short films are IF THEN ELSE and CORRESPONDENCE, an epistolary conversation with Dominga Sotomayor shown in Visions du Réel, New York Film Festival or San Sebastian. ALCARRÀS is Carla's second feature. It took part in the Torino Script Lab, Nipkow Program, MFI and Cannes Residency.





NURIA GIMÉNEZ LORANG, 2019 Non-Fiction. Drama

The intimate diary of a Swiss woman from a well-to-do background is illustrated through the homespun films of her husband. a wealthy industrialist, between the 1940s and 1960s. As the couple embark on their travels around the world, their story grows more unpredictable and improbable.

Nuria Giménez was born in Barcelona in 1976. She studied Journalism. International Relations and Documentary Filmmaking. She has lived in Berlin, Paris and London doing different types of jobs, most of them unrelated to cinema or to each other. In the last decade, she has extended her knowledge thanks to seminars and master classes of several filmmakers she admires, like Isaki Lacuesta, Andrés Duque, Virginia García del Pino, Sergei Dvortsevoy, Patricio Guzmán, Wang Bing, Mark Isaacs, Stephen Frears or Frederick Wiseman. Her first short film, KAFENEIO, was presented at DocumentaMadrid 2017 and MIDBO 2017. MY MEXICAN BRETZEL is her first feature film.
